These sessions, previously part of the ACM schedule as Regional Networking Sessions, are scheduled late on Sunday afternoon. They allow participants from each region to learn about the CUCs activity in their region and about the accomplishments of other congregations.

We urge you to plan now to ensure that your congregation is represented and to encourage your members to attend so that they can learn more about how others are meeting the challenges of congregational life.

During the 3 minutes (I know it isn't very long) that each congregation has to share their 'story' we invite you to share, using the following guidelines.

“Introduce” your congregation

- Tell us how many adults and children are part of your community.
- Describe your Ministerial & Staff roles (if any).
- Tell us if you meet in your own or rented space.

Tell us how you Go-4-It (this is your chance to 'brag')

Provide examples of how your congregation has, in the past year, engaged in each of the Go-4-It directions:

Go On – Good initiatives or programs you have sustained.

Go Deep – Programs and opportunities that challenge members to stretch spiritually, personally, interpersonally and intellectually.

Go Out – The ways your congregation has made itself known in the larger community.

Go Big – Some of the ways your congregation has 'made a difference' in the lives of its members or in the community.
