Suggested Discussion Items:

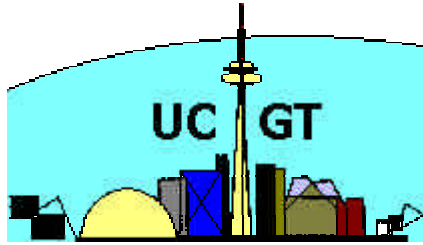
- i) Who are we? (Names and e-mail addresses of those present and those absent who practice in our area of interest.)
