



This symbol was developed by the Unitarian Congregations of Greater Toronto to represent "the Unitarian*Universalist path" in a way that is not restricted to any one congregation or geographic region. This was made possible by using input from U*Us across Canada who voiced their hopes and aspirations in congregational workshops held as part of the CUC's Statement of Principles project in 2004.

The union of Universalist and Unitarian theologies is depicted by the presence of a bold and unique path for each and every individual, within the embrace of an over-arching cosmic unity. Our combined humanist and religious tradition is clear in the human figure - portrayed as the pivotal connection between the cosmos and the living earth.

The single word "Unitarian" was chosen simply to aid in the promotion and "brand recognition" of our movement, calling to those who do not yet know us. This was a purely pragmatic consideration, since the combined influences of Unitarian, Universalist, Humanist and other religious theologies and philosophies are so rich and varied within our movement that they could never be meaningfully summarized in only one or two words!

The tagline "ever moving ever still" captures the ever-changing nature of our living tradition while acknowledging that which is timeless and constant.
